OPERATOR

Definition: Landfill Equipment Operator is responsible for safely operating heavy machinery, front-end loaders, compactors, excavators, and graders are primarily used to spread, compact, and cover waste, while also performing routine maintenance checks on the equipment and ensuring compliance with safety and environmental regulations, identifying hazardous materials, and maintaining proper landfill grading and coverage. Under supervision of Operations Supervisor and/or Landfill Operations Manager, performs a variety of semi-skilled and unskilled work associated with maintaining the Salt River Landfill.

Tasks:

- Knowledge on a verify of landfill heavy equipment.
- The ability to work outdoors in all weather conditions, climb in and out of heavy equipment frequently, and lift moderately heavy objects.
- Maintain operational logs, documenting equipment usage, waste volume, and any incidents or maintenance activities.
- Assists with the maintenance of Landfill grounds both manually and by using equipment for tasks such as digging, hauling or spreading dirt, concrete, and rock.
- Operates a roll off truck to load and unload roll off bins.
- Perform pre- and post-trip inspections and record any breakdowns.
- Perform routine preventive maintenance on equipment operated.
- Wash landfill equipment as needed.
- Miscellaneous jobs and duties as requested.

Knowledge, Skills, Abilities and Other Characteristics:

- Knowledge of basic Landfill safety procedures.
- Ability to proficiently operate the water wagon, roll-off truck and loader.
- Ability to operate and communicate over a two-way radio.

Work environment:

- Primarily outdoors, exposed to weather elements
- Loud noise from operating machinery
- Potential exposure to dust and odors
- May require working on uneven terrain

Safety

- Adhere to all OSHA/ Landfill safety protocols, wear required personal protective equipment and follow traffic control procedures at the landfill.

Minimum Qualifications:

- **Insurability:** Must possess a valid Arizona operator's license and be insurable under the tribal insurer requirements which are outlined as follows. Must be 21 years of age for all driving positions which require transporting others as a routine job duty. Driving disqualifications will occur if during the last three (3) years, the driver has any of the following convictions: for a felony; sale, handling or use of drugs; alcohol or drug related offense that is automobile related; three (3) or more speeding violations; more than two (2) speeding tickets more than 15 mph; one or more other serious violations. "Serious violations" are defined as: driving under the influence of alcohol/drugs; violation for alcohol offence during use of a vehicle; failure to stop/report an

accident; driving while impaired; making a false accident report; homicide, manslaughter or assault arising out of the use of a vehicle; driving while license is suspended or revoked; racing; attempting to elude a police officer. Other disqualifications would include having a driver's license suspended or revoked and involvement in two (2) or more chargeable incidents.

- Must be able to pass pre-employment and random drug screening tests.
- Graduation from high school, GED or years of experience.
